### Our programs for the 2010-2011 school year:

3's - Barbara	T & Th	9:15-11:30AM	\$70 month	3 by Dec 1, 2010
3/4's - Barbara	T & Th	1:00-3:15PM	\$70 month	3 by Dec 1, 2010
4's - Annie	MWF	9:15-11:30AM	\$95 month	4 by Dec 1, 2010
Pre-K - Annie	MWF	12:45-3:15PM	\$100 month	5 by June 15, 2010

Each class has a maximum enrollment of 22. A typical day starts with an art project as children arrive. The class then gathers in the circle area for approximately 15 minutes of stories, songs, and discussion. This is followed by 45 minutes of free play. During free play, available activities include: a sensory table, kitchen, cars, games, costumes and puppets available both upstairs and in the basement for large motor play. Free play is followed by cleanup time before an additional circle time. This is followed by a snack and finally outside playground time before dismissal.

### Parent participation:

Each class will have two to three assist parents based on class size:

- Curb Parent—Responsible for getting children out of cars in the curb cut and bringing them into the classroom. Also assists with taking children to the cars at the end of the day.
- Art Parent—Supervises art project for the day
- Snack Parent—Provides the snack and supervises the basement during free play. We are a peanut free facility.

Parents will rotate through the roles on your assist days. The average assist frequency is twice a month in the 4 yr olds & Pre-K classes & once a month in the 3 & 3/4 yr old classes.

In addition to classroom assists, each family is responsible for:

- one weekend cleanup per year
- one seasonal work day per year
- one school job
- attending 2 general meetings
- selling \$50 in raffle tickets in the spring (or purchasing the tickets outright)
- participating in optional fundraising at your discretion
